- We have our own Equipment Operator from May thru October. He installs all non-ag. practices done in our County through our Soil and Water Conservation District.
- We Co-Own an Excavator, and Dozer with our County Highway Department.
- We Co-Own a Roller with Chemung County Soil and Water Conservation District.
- We own our own Dump Truck
- We also utilize an immense amount of borrowed equipment from our Towns, County, and Chemung County Soil and Water.
